

From the <b>Behavior</b> tab, click the <b>New</b>.           <div style="border: 1px solid gray; padding: 5px; margin: 5px 0;"> <p><b>*Role</b></p> <div style="border: 1px solid gray; height: 20px; width: 100%;"></div> </div> <p><b>Role Descriptions:</b>  <b>Offender</b> – Person committing the act, wrongdoer, defied the rules, cause of the anger.  <b>Participant</b> –Person contributing or taking part in the act, accomplice.  <b>Victim</b> –Person who the act was committed upon, sufferer, wounded, injured party, fatality.  <b>Witness</b> – Person who hears first hand evidence about the event, observer, bystander, onlooker, eyewitness.</p> </li> <li>2.
